We spent approximately two years working on the changes to the Constitution, By-Laws, and Endowment Policy. A special thank you goes out to each of these people for spending the countless hours discussing, revising, and reviewing these policies.

Here are a few notes on the changes proposed. Most were just making the documents flow better and correcting grammatical errors.....

Our Board will consist of 6 members Pastor termination only with 2/3 vote from Spiritual Leadership Team and 2/3 vote from the Board.
